A. SIGNIFICANT NOTES ON ACTIVITIES

SRIJAN MAHILA VIKASH MANCHestablish in the year 2000 in the state of Jharkhand. B. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

 Basis of Accounting: The Accounting Standards issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India are applicable to non-profit entities, only if any part of the activities of the entity is considered to be commercial, industrial or business in nature.

The Society is not carrying on any activity in nature of commercial, industrial or business therefore the Accounting Standards are not mandatory and have been followed to the extent practicable or relevant.

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and on accrual basis except stated otherwise. The accounting policies have been consistently applied by the society except stated otherwise.

2. Fixed Assets: Assets are stated at cost of acquisition including taxes, duties and other incidental expenses relating to acquisition and installation.

3. **Depreciation:** Depreciation on the depreciable assets is charged on written down value method as per the rates and manner prescribed under Appendix 1 to the Income Tax Rule 1962.

As the total value of the Assets acquired out of the Grant fund is charged to revenue during the year of purchase, depreciation on such assets is adjusted against the Assets Fund for disclosure purpose in the Balance Sheet.

- 4. Revenue Recognition: Restricted project grants were recognized as income on the grant received during the project period on the prorate basis of respective projects, whereas unrestricted project grants and Donations were recognized on the basis of receipts in accordance to the guidelines on "Not for Profit Organization" issued by The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.
- 5. Grant Receivable: Expenses incurred in excess of the grant received during the year, in accordance of the memorandum of the understanding or terms of reference with the funder, has been recognized as grant receivable and these balances were disclosed under the head current assets vide schedule No.-06 of the Balance Sheet.
- 6. Project Fund: The Project Fund was recognized on the basis of unspent balance of Grant Recognized as income over the grant utilized during the period. Grant Income of the year, to the extent unutilized has transferred to Project Fund vide schedule -No.-02 of the Balance Sheet.
- 7. Bank Interest: Interest earnedon saving bank account is reflected under the Income & Expenditure Account after allocating such interest derived on unutilized donor funds. The interest is accounted under the Receipts & Payment Account as the total interest received during the period from 01.04.2017 to 31.03.2018 in the savings bank account and fixed deposits.

- 8. Expenditure: Expenses are recorded on accrual basis (Except Statutory Audit Fees).
- Foreign Contribution: Foreign Contributions are accounted for on the basis of the credit advice received from bank.

C. NOTES TO ACCOUNTS

- Income & Expenses incurred out of Foreign Grants are generally disclosed as per the requirements of the Rule 5 of Foreign Contribution Regulation Rule 2011.
